

Paper Plate Animal Masks

Gather

- Paper plates
- Crayons or markers
- Glue or tape
- Scissors
- Sticks (popsicle sticks, plastic dinnerware, twigs from outside, etc.)
- Construction paper (or white paper that is colored with markers/crayons)

Let's Create!

- 1. Press the paper plate against your face. With a crayon or marker, do your best to mark the plate where your eyes are.
- 2. Cut small eye holes where you have marked on the plate.
- 3. Color and cut pieces of paper for ears, beaks, & noses. Go online or use animal books for assistance.
- 4. Glue or tape the paper pieces to the paper plate.
- 5. Add any other details with crayon or marker.
- 6. Tape your stick to the back of the plate.
