A² Everyone is Special Program

The *Everyone is Special* (EIS) program is an extension of Amazement Square's educational priorities to cultivate an engaged community of lifelong learners and ensure hands-on experiential learning is accessible to all abilities. Through this program Amazement Square is able to provide unique museum exploration experiences to children who have been diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder, their siblings, and parents. Additionally, this program funds STEAM based experiential learning programs that Amazement Square brings into the public school system for their adaptive learning classrooms.



Amazing Children

Amazement Square has been working in partnership with early learning centers for at-risk children throughout the Lynchburg area for over 10 years to address an important community need for high quality learning. The program, Amazing Children, works with centers providing classroom structure and a social-emotional curriculum to students; supporting emerging teachers through modeling, mentoring, and professional development; and incorporating center directors to develop awareness of best practices in the field and reduce staff turnover. Amazement Square currently serves 6 different centers throughout the school year as well as summer based programs and plans to expand the program to reach several more early learning centers.
